ID-AYU0818) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- 1. I am to refer to your application vide ref no. NSVKM/AYURVEDIC/2022/147 dated 19.10.2022 received from The President, Nootan Sarve Vidayalaya Kevalani Mandal, Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist- Mehsana - 384315, Gujarat for seeking permission of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine to establish a new Ayurveda Medical College in the name of Nootan Ayurvedic College & Research Centre, Sankalchand patel University, Gandhinagar - Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist - Mehsana- 384315, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0818) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24 and to verify the physical and other infrastructure facilities available, the college was visited on 25.09.2023 and 26.09.2023 on hybrid mode by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine.
- 2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
- 3. As Per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report and all other related documents were placed in the 62nd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 04.10.2023. Board discussed the same and found that the College is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Letter of Intent (LOI) to establish new Ayurvedic Medical College with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.

- In view of above, Letter of Intent (LOI) is issued to The President, Nootan Sarve Vidayalaya Kevalani Mandal, Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist- Mehsana - 384315, Gujarat to establish a new Ayurvedic Medical college in the name of Nootan Ayurvedic College & Research Centre, Sankalchand patel University, Gandhinagar - Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist - Mehsana- 384315, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0818) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2023-24 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under, subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before issuance of Letter of permission (LOP) for the academic session 2023-24, failing which the Letter of Permission (LOP) shall not be issued and Letter of Intent (LOI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn.
 - The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016.
 - The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019.

 - iv. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.

- In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn without further intimation to the applicant.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. NSVKM/AYURVEDIC/2022/147dated 19.10.2022 received from Nootan Sarve Vidayalaya Kevalani Mandal Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist-Mehsana-384315, Gujarat to verify the available facilities of teaching and practical training for the intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2023-24, the college was visited on 25.09.2023 and 26.09.2023 on hybrid mode for issuance of LOI by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and as per direction of competent authority letter of intent has been issued you vide letter of even no. dated 05.10.2023 to establish new Ayurveda college in the name of of Nootan Ayurvedic College & Research Centre, Sankalchand patel University, Gandhinagar- Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist-Mehsana-384315, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0818) for intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under Section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.
- The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the institution again on 26.10.2023 & 27.10.2023 through Hybrid mode to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and to verify the physical and other infrastructure facilities available for issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP) to establish new Ayurveda college in the name of Nootan Ayurvedic College & Research Centre, Sankalchand patel University, Gandhinagar-Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist- Mehsana-384315, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0818) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic section 2023-24 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 3. In view of above as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report and all other related documents were placed in the 67th Board Meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 31.10.2023. Board decided to issue letter of Permission to start new Ayurvedic medical college with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.

- 4. Further, in accordance of Section 6 (1) (i) (ii) of "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019, Vide letter of even no. dated 29.09.2023 a letter was sent to you to furnish Fixed security deposit worth rupees 02 Crore (Two crore) in favour of National Commission fund for Indian System of Medicine for the period of five years. In response of the same you have furnished the fixed security deposit amount of Rupees 02 Crore (Two crore) in favour of the National Commission fund for the Indian system of Medicine through RTGS having UTR no. MSNUR52023110100273649 dated 01.11.2023 from the Mehsana Urban Co-Op Bank Limited, Visnagar Gujarat (for a period of five years) and informed the same vide letter no. 1008/2023-24 dated 01.11.2023.
- 5. Therefore, Letter of Permission (LOP) is issued to Nootan Sarve Vidayalaya Kevalani Mandal Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist- Mehsana-384315, Gujarat to establish new Ayurvedic Medical college in the name of Nootan Ayurvedic College & Research Centre, Sankalchand patel University, Gandhinagar- Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist- Mehsana-384315, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0818) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2023-24 under Section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder subject to the following conditions: -
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of **100 seats** shall be treated as all India quota. The counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 7. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or subsequent year.
- 8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
 - The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016";
- ii. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2019"
- iii. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016";
- iv. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020.
- 10. The College administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the NCISM ACT and relevant regulation thereunder, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS is made, under intimation to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.
- 11. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for I, II and III professionals well in time as per the norms which will be verified by the medical assessment and rating board and accordingly the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be considered.

On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcoming/defect have been observed
 - i. Teaching Staff :-
- ii. - 3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the 91st Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 24.05.2024 and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, but fulfilling the criteria required for renewal of permission as mentioned in Regulation 3 and as per note mentioned in Schedule-V of MSR 2016. Hence, Board decided to issue 1st renewal of permission with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- 4. Therefore, 1st renewal of permission is granted to Nootan Ayurvedic College & Research Centre, Sankalchandpatel University, Gandhinagar- Ambaji State Highway, Visnagar, Dist- Mehsana-384315, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0818) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcoming shall be fulfilled along with the following requirements: -
 - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 6. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and compliance report should be sent to get permission for the academic session 2025-2026:
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.

- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 2 above, should be fulfilled.
- 9. The College administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the NCISM ACT and relevant regulation thereunder, are in position before the admission of the 2ndbatch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS is made, under intimation to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM.
- 10. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for I, II and III professionals well in time as per the norms which will be verified by the medical assessment and rating board and accordingly the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be considered.
- 11. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 35 of the NCISM Act, 2020 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
- 12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
